1. **Is it required to be a licensed contractor to bid and work on this project? No. As mentioned in the bid documents, a contractor is an individual, partnership, corporation, or business entity that enters into a contract for services with a public agency. Anyone meeting that description can bid the project. It was noticed that the current Bid Form included a line for contractor's license. Since this is not required, it has been removed from the revised Bid Form attached.**
2. **There is only one authorized representative for IDEC. Will the owner accept any other integrators for this project? No.**
3. **The City desires to incorporate SCADA modifications into the Avon Park Control Panel Modifications project to provide the City the ability to control the water treatment plant equipment via SCADA (i.e. chemical feed, pumps, etc). The Bid is to include this work into the total lump sum bid and information on the SCADA system proposed. Work includes modifying the existing Data Flow System or installing a new SCADA system that allows the City to monitor and control the water treatment plant remotely. As a result, the deadline for questions and the bid opening has been extended to December 11th and December 15th at 2pm. In addition, a non-mandatory site visit at the water treatment place will take place next Monday, November 23, @ 8:30am to discuss SCADA.**
